

The town of Wayne also continued to stay busy these last months. We recently welcomed Burtons Grill & Bar to town with a fantastic grand opening and ribbon cutting ceremony. Burtons is in the former Chili's location at 312 West Lancaster Avenue and is a great dining and bar addition. We have seen progress at a few new retailers that are slated to open shortly. World Wide Stereo (the former Starbucks location at 218 East Lancaster Avenue) will be a welcomed addition to the downtown area. And we FINALLY have some signs of life at the old GAP location as the window treatments for Ballard Designs are up. Ballard is relocating from the King of Prussia Mall and will be a fine addition to the block. In terms of food, not one, but TWO new and exciting restaurants are coming to town from Fearless Restaurants – Triple Crown in the newly-renovated Radnor Hotel brings upscale dining, bar, and banquet facilities (and terrace seating!), as well as Testa Rossa on the other side of Wayne, bringing upscale Italian dining to the former Bertucci's location. WOW! Construction has started on the West Avenue public parking lot and should be completed by Labor Day. This will be a great alternative parking location on West Avenue with direct access to downtown Wayne.

We anticipate that it will be a very busy fall of ribbon cuttings in Wayne, just in time for the Radnor Fall Festival on Sunday, September 21! 

