

Member Meetings

Ribbon Cutting and Anniversary Ceremonies

Discount Merchant/Employee Parking

The WBA negotiated discount parking for Wayne Business Overlay District (WBOD) merchants and employees. Discount parking is available in 3 parking lots throughout Wayne: West Avenue Lot, South Wayne Lot, and Louella Lot. A parking map with times, hours, lot, and kiosk locations can be found on the WBA website. A \$100 card can be purchased by any merchant or employee in the WBOD for \$25!

High School Scholarship Award

\$1,000 is given annually to deserving and eligible high school seniors. These individuals must be employed by a member of the Wayne Business Association.

RADNOR TOWNSHIP OPENS A NEW PARKING LOT ON WEST AVENUE IN DOWNTOWN WAYNE!

We are very pleased to announce that construction is now complete on the West Avenue Parking Lot which ensures all Wayne visitors have plenty of parking options when heading into downtown for a bite to eat or a bit of shopping!

Radnor Township's West Avenue Parking Lot is located directly across the street from the AT&T building, adjacent to the train tracks, on West Avenue.

Renovation highlights include:

- West Avenue Parking Lot opened November 3, 2025
- 108 new parking spots
- Kiosked parking & ParkMobile app available
- Modern design aesthetic including new plantings, blacktop, and lighting
- Convenient, direct sidewalk access to Downtown Wayne for visitors, diners, and shoppers!

Thanks to the Radnor Parking Auxiliary, two kiosks for metered parking are now available and the ParkMobile app is also a payment option at the West Avenue Parking Lot. **Please note**, payment for parking will ask for input of your license plate number instead of a numbered parking space. After considering public requests for a change to park by license plate, Radnor Parking Auxiliary has successfully implemented this change in the West Avenue Parking Lot and by 2026 all Township parking lots will implement parking by license plate.

We welcome everyone to enjoy the new West Avenue Parking Lot just a few hundred feet from Wayne restaurants and businesses this holiday season and year-round!

(The current Bellevue Parking Lot on Lancaster Avenue near Boyds is now closed to the public and is under construction as it will soon become 60 West, a 45-unit residential space including underground parking.)



The in-person public workshop for the A Vision for Wayne 2035 Master Plan held Thursday, February 5 at the Township Building was a huge success! With close to 100 attendees, the discussions were lively and the feedback was plentiful. The Township appreciates everyone who came out on such a cold night!

"Everything Is Personal"
 at *Colonna Contemporary*
 4 Louella Court, Wayne

On Exhibit February 13-March 20

This exhibition brings together four artists – Dafne Berg, Jacqueline Rose, Mikey Wilson, and Megan Kelley – whose practices are unapologetically subjective. Their work resists the anonymity of trend-driven production, favoring instead a language shaped by intuition, repetition, and emotional truth. While their approaches differ in form and material, each artist treats the act of making as a form of personal reckoning – one that privileges honesty over spectacle.

These works do not perform for their surroundings; they insist on interiority. They invite viewers into spaces that are intimate rather than declarative, where meaning unfolds slowly and interpretation remains open.

What connects these artists is not aesthetic similarity, but a shared commitment to presence.

Their work asks to be met with attention rather than explanation, offering moments of recognition that feel less like statements and more like conversations.

In centering artists working locally, the exhibition affirms that relevance is not a matter of geography, but of depth – and that some of the most compelling voices are found close to home, when we choose to look closely.
